

Sojourn as Sacrament

For thirteen years, St. Francis High School in Sacramento has sent its seniors to the Jesuit Retreat Center of Los Altos. Five times a year, a busload of fifty retreatants, along with their adult and student leaders, makes the 125 mile pilgrimage for a Kairos retreat. Anticipation mounts each time the bus navigates the corner onto Manresa Way. As the bus strains up the hill, the stressful, everyday world is transformed into a sanctuary of quiet beauty and holiness. The students know that they have entered into a special place and that they are about to experience something unique and profound.

Kairos means "God's Time." It is time spent with the Lord, exploring one's life, one's relationships, and one's spirituality. The Kairos retreat program is an age appropriate modification of the Ignatian Spiritual Exercises. It is a process of encountering God and being inspired to grow closer in relationship with the Lord. The atmosphere of El Retiro lends itself to Kairos and to the deep, quiet reflection this retreat process requires. Could there be a better place to clear one's mind to allow God's voice to be heard?

Graduates of St. Francis report Kairos to be the most important experience of their high school years. They attest to the transformative nature of Kairos as evidenced in their lives once they return home. Bonds with parents, family, and friends are strengthened. Self-acceptance, forgiveness, and love are shown in word and deed. A clearer understanding of God and the transformative power of a deeper, personal relationship with God are the greatest gifts of time spent in this holy space.

One is forever changed by Kairos. One graduate wisely exclaimed, "The whole world should go on Kairos!"

The Spiritual Journey of St. Luke's Family Practice

St. Luke's Family Practice of Modesto is in its seventh year of providing free primary health care to uninsured patients. Drs. Robert Forester and R.J. Heck serve in response to many blessings given by the Lord, including the role played by El Retiro in their spiritual journeys.

St. Luke's is a unique, non-profit medical practice. Half of the time it provides care to a group of insured patients, called "benefactors," who make annual payments in return for unparalleled service. These patients have direct 24/7 access to their physician by cell phone or email, extended same-day appointments, and home visits, and the clinic's funds come almost

exclusively from their support. This allows the doctors to spend the other half of their time providing free care for the uninsured who do not qualify for government programs.

Dr. Forester became a Catholic in the early 1990's and slowly incorporated Catholic teachings into his medical practice. While vacationing with his family in 2000, during a moment of prayer, the concept came to

him – *Can't great care for a few generous patients fund a clinic for the uninsured?* Dr. Heck was raised in a Catholic family and had a busy and successful practice, as well. In February 2002, he suffered a stroke resulting from a snowboarding injury. He made a near miraculous recovery to full health and felt drawn to move in a more altruistic direction.

Though the doctors were acquaintances, they were in different practices across town. Both had children in the same parish school. In September 2002, after the two couples enjoyed a dinner together, Dr.

Forester shared the idea with Dr. Heck, who was immediately drawn to it.

The next fifteen months were frenzied, the doctors working at their busy practices and discreetly planning St. Luke's. The clinic opened in January

2004 with a slow start, but has steadily grown on both sides of the practice. Currently, it has a full panel of Benefactors and has provided over 10,000 free visits to uninsured patients, at a value of almost \$1 million.

The clinic has always had a priest as spiritual director. However, diocesan reassignments disrupted continuity. By the fourth year of the practice, the doctors felt somewhat disconnected from each other and lacked a common focus on the mission of the practice. Happily, they found a new spiritual advisor, Ernesto Arbelaez, S.J., at their home parish. Fr. Ernesto recommended the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius done in everyday life, over the course of some months.

Both doctors began with retreats at El Retiro, individually directed by Fr. Bernie Bush, S.J. Both found the time enriching, a rare three-day stretch to pray, reflect, and rest. Over the next ten months they completed the Exercises. They found improved clarity and perspective in their work. They came to recognize the very different gifts that each brought to St. Luke's, and they learned to appreciate each other's talents.

Each doctor returns every six months for an individually-directed retreat. Each has his favorite spot to sit and pray at El Retiro: Dr. Forester prefers the Montserrat Chapel, Dr. Heck the bench up by the water tank on the hill. Fr. Bush has helped both

A Director's Perspective: Los Altos Stories

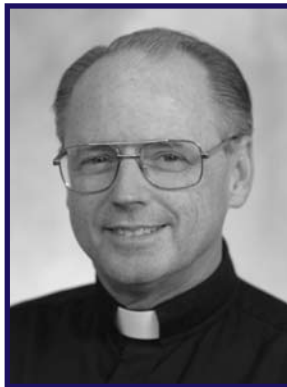

We are grateful for that faithful response to the gift the Spirit offers here. Bill De Mers—95 years young!—was with us recently for his annual Knights of Columbus retreat. Such loyalty is edifying.

We are blessed to have with us this "semester" Fr. Ken Hezel, S.J. He is spending the second half of his sab-

batical serving on the Retreat Center's Pastoral Staff and getting to know all the golf courses in the Bay Area. Ken will return in June to the Caroline-Marshall Islands, where he has served as a missionary for decades, most recently as Regional Superior.

St. Ignatius often observed that we ought to be able to find God in all things. He expected, as well, that we can learn to pray anywhere. Ignatius ordinarily offered the Spiritual Exercises in the cities, distracting as they were and are, and he tailored the Spiritual Exercises to help us toward the freedom to pray—to "find God"—wherever we find ourselves.

Do consider whether the Spirit is calling you to make the Spiritual Exercises. We offer the complete Exercises in an individually-directed, silent retreat of thirty days (in a 36-day program) each summer. For those who cannot set aside that time, the complete Exercises can be done in everyday life, over the course of thirty weeks or more. Dear Friends,

From the vantage point of spring and of celebrating together, as Church, the Paschal Mystery of Christ's dying and rising, we have a helpful perspective on the challenges of 2008 and 2009 and since. Our Ignatian hope that we be able to find God in all things has been put to the test, not least of all by the impact of economic difficulty around the globe.

The Retreat Center experiences both the challenge and the hope. We are happy to be able to share with you in this Annual Report some reflections on, and some statistics from, the year. The Donor List records the gifts we have received during the calendar year 2009. The financial statistics reflect the fiscal year which concluded on June 30, 2009.


There are rays of light: our retreats draw an ever broader spectrum of people seeking to know God more deeply and to live their Christian discipleship in greater freedom; we again offered retreats for the homeless and for Homeboys, and we added our first retreat for Homegirls; we hosted more groups in 2009 than in 2008, and we welcomed 266 more high school students in 2009 than in the year prior, which bodes well for our future; the Pierre Favre Program, in its fourth year, prepares lay people and Jesuits to give the Spiritual Exercises (six have graduated and more than thirty are now in the program); the members of our Advisory Board share their wisdom and experience in a process of planning toward the future of El Retiro's governance, ministry, and facilities; we have been able to reduce expenses in a number of areas, a process which is continuing quite successfully.

We see shadows, as well: attendance at our own retreats during 2009 was off by 90 from our 2008 total, and attendance at the retreats we host was off by 144; neither foundation grants nor bequests came our way during the fiscal year; individual donations, reflecting the difficult times, were off by over 15%; our investments lost significant value, even as, because of the decline in other areas of income, we had to transfer more funds from those investments than in previous years.

I thank you, our benefactors, for your continuing generosity despite the financial setbacks that so many have endured. I am grateful for the confidence in our ministry that your gifts indicate, and let's pray together that directors who succeed me and retreatants who follow you will reap the benefits of our stewardship in the decades ahead.

Carmel Smith has recently completed ten years of service here at El Retiro, ever charming one and all with her welcoming spirit and the Irish lilt in her voice. Please join me in thanking her for the caring attention she has shown to our retreatants over the course of these years.

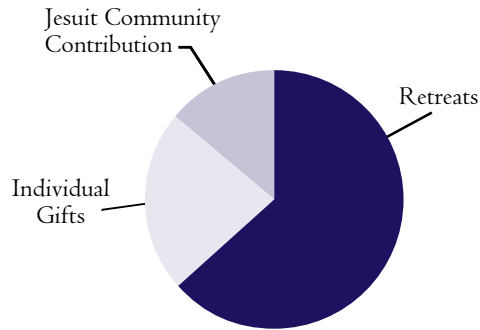

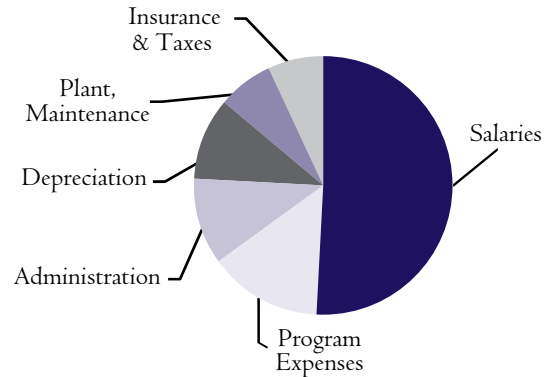
